



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Although every effort will be taken to ensure all the activities take place, the management reserves the right to cancel at any time and where possible offer a suitable alternative.
- To guarantee your child's space payment must be made in full at time of booking. An enrolment form must be completed prior to registration and/or updated if details have changed.
- Payment can be made by cash, card or cheque. Cheques must be made payable to **HUISH LEISURE LIMITED**.
- If you wish to cancel a booking you must provide us with 48 hour notice period in order to qualify for a full refund. If you cancel a session within the 48 hour notice period then unfortunately we are unable to offer a refund or credit.
- If you wish to transfer sessions from one day to another you must provide us with 48 hour notice and must pay the difference if the cost is higher. No refunds/credits will be made for sessions that cost less when transferred and the session can only be transferred during the same holiday period.
- A parent/guardian needs to sign the child in for every session. For collection the child/children need to be signed out and we ask that you collect them on time. If you are happy for your child to leave on their own, then we will need written confirmation outlining this for each separate occasion.
- It is the parents/guardians responsibility to provide a packed lunch.
- The Sports centre has no refrigeration facilities for storing food, so please keep this in mind then preparing your child's packed lunch. Please provide a re-usable drinks bottle can that can be filled up during the day. Lunch boxes, drinks bottles and clothing need to have a clear label.
- For trampolining sessions please ensure children wear socks and have long hair tied back.
- We are unable to supply sun cream and hats/caps for the children so please ensure that the children provide their own, staff will encourage the children for both the use and application of the above.
- Children are responsible for all clothing and personal possessions brought to the Schools Out Programme. Any valuables should be given to the play leaders. Huish Leisure Limited accepts no responsibility for items lost or damage during the schools out programme.
- It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to inform the sports centre of any medical/dietary conditions that the child may have.
- It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to provide the child with full working and safe equipment for activities such as triathlon and cycling. Suitable clothing must be worn for all activities. Helmets must be provided for all cycling activities.
- If any child does require the administration of medication during their session then they must be provided by the parent/guardian with written explanation of when/how the medication should be administered and permission to do so.
- The sports centre has no facilities for caring for sick children, so if your child is sick please do not bring them to the sports centre. If your child is taken ill whilst with us you will be contacted and asked to collect them as soon as possible. It is very important that the sports centre be informed of confirmed cases of head-lice and threadworms or any other contagious diseases.
- An emergency contact number must be provided and it is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to inform us if this changes so we can update our records accordingly.
- By signing the daily registration signing in sheet and completing an enrolment form you are agreeing to our terms and conditions and confirming that you are happy/providing permission for your child to take part in the activities involved within that session.
- Children must not be dropped off until 5 minutes before the booked session is due to start.
- Photography may be taken for publicity purposes please inform the centre if you do not wish for your child to be included. It is the parents/guardians responsibility to update the centre to any changes.
